SALT LAKE COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY DETERMINES MURRAY POLICE OFFICER INVOLVED SHOOTING "JUSTIFIED."

Salt Lake City, UT | Last week, Salt Lake County District Attorney Sim Gill informed Murray Police Chief Peter A. Fondaco that the DA's Office determined that Officer D. Stallings use of deadly force against Ryan Robinson on April 9, 2012, at approximately 6270 S. Mount Vernon Drive, Murray, UT, was "justified" under Utah State law.

The Office of the Salt Lake County District Attorney, Sim Gill, Salt Lake County District Attorney is required by Utah State law, and operates pursuant to an agreement with participating law enforcement agencies, consistent with established protocols and applicable law, to perform joint investigations and independent reviews of officer involved critical incidents, including police officers' use of deadly (including potentially deadly) force used in the scope of police officers' official duties.

The findings and conclusions of the above referenced incident, as supported by the facts developed during the joint investigation of the incident are contained in the attached letter to Murray Police Chief Fondaco.
