SALT LAKE COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY FILES ATTEMPTED MURDER CHARGE, OTHER CHARGES IN ATTACK ON ATTORNEY STEVEN KILLPACK

Salt Lake City, UT | Today, Salt Lake County District Attorney's Office, Sim Gill, Salt Lake County District Attorney, filed multiple felony charges relating to the recent attack on Steven Killpack, a local defense attorney. The defendant, Matthew Christopher Wall, was charged with attempted murder, aggravated burglary and two counts of possession of a dangerous weapon by a restricted person. Under Utah State law, attempted murder is a first degree felony, punishable by a prison term up to life in prison; aggravated burglary is also a first degree felony punishable by a prison term up to life in prison; each count of possession of a dangerous weapon by a restricted person is a third degree felony punishable by a prison term of zero to five years.

The charges originate from an alleged attack on July 5, 2012. Bail has been set at \$1,000,007.00
