History Note

The position of Salt Lake County Treasurer was created in 1852, (Utah Code Annotated, 1876, title 4, chapter 4, p. 130). The mission of the Salt Lake County Treasurer is to efficiently administer the property tax billing, collection and property tax relief programs for Salt Lake County, and professionally and prudently manage all monies belonging to the County and others as directed by law. The primary responsibility of the Salt Lake County Treasurer is to collect county fees and taxes. The treasurer falls under the administration of the county commissioners (known as the county court prior to statehood).

Scope and Content Note

Salt Lake County Treasurer, Assessment Rolls, Index to Mines 1898-1909. There are letters above each year, possibly denoting the volume to reference. The mines are listed alphabetically and show the abbreviated name of the mining district. There are two numbers listed for mines under each year, presumably referring to a page and a line of a nonexistent record book.
