SLCO SUPPLIER US BANK - PAYMENT PLUS PROGRAM

In 2016, Salt Lake County partnered with US Bank to implement an important initiative to expand our commercial card program by utilizing their Payment Plus product. The County would like to begin paying suppliers using Visa Commercial Card instead of a check or other payment methods. The following are some of the valuable benefits that a supplier can receive from this program:

- Accelerated payment and improved cash flow – these invoices are paid immediately, not paid according to the terms on invoice/contract. The quicker the invoice is submitted to AP, the quicker payment will be received by the supplier
- Reduced paperwork and streamlined accounts receivable process
- Real-time notification for each card payment
- Complete remittance detail to support efficient receivables posting
- No changes or modifications to the suppliers existing card acceptance procedures
