*For example, the Collective Impact on Homelessness committee created this shared vision statement: In Salt Lake County, we provide housing and services as quickly as possible to those who are homeless. We want everyone in our community to have a safe place to live. We want our homeless housing and services solutions to be system-oriented rather than agency-oriented and to promote engagement rather than enablement. We use our collective expertise, resources and data to continuously improve our homeless housing and service systems so that they are safe, integrated, and efficient and focused on self-sufficiency.*
