Positive	Negative	Category	Outcome
29	0	Prevention	The housing supply will meet the demand and need of residents
28	2	Prevention	Individuals and families will have access to the services and supports needed to prevent homelessness, and if they return to homelessness we will know why so we can prevent it from happening again.
24	0	Community + Public Spaces	Homeless individuals seeking services in high concentration areas will have access to employment, job training, transportation and positive alternative activities in between services.
19	0	Individuals + Families	Individuals and Families will have access to basic needs and stabilization services when they need them
18	1	System	We will have a "no wrong door" service system: coordinated entry will provide easy access to services
17	0	System	Salt Lake County's homelessness rates will decrease over time

9	11	Community + Public Spaces 2	Pioneer Park and other high concentration areas will be welcoming and safe for all families, homeless individuals, and businesses. There will be no dealing in public spaces and less desperate crowds. 3
8	1	System	The homeless service system will have fidelity to best practices that are applicable to the community
4	0	Prevention	Young people will not experience homelessness
3	1	System	Providers will have a common feedback mechanism in place to measure the quality of the response system
2	3	System	Trust will exist between participants, providers and funders
<p>1 The negative votes for this outcome reflected concern that the language might encourage policies that force people out of shelter on a timeline rather than help support a quick, successful exit. In the final review conducted by survey, this outcome will be re-worded and thus may be prioritized differently.</p> <p>2 In this category, three people also "voted" to remove the phrase "public spaces" from the outcome.</p> <p>3 In this category, there was conversatoin about Pioneer Park being identified specifically. It was agreed to revise this outcome to address system-level issues of safety and security.
