Emigration Canyon safety recommendations to be presented today

Emigration Township, Utah – The Emigration Canyon Roadway Improvement Committee, or ECRIC, will present a safety assessment and final report with more than 100 recommendations to improve canyon safety to the Salt Lake County Council today during the 1:00 PM Council of the Whole meeting.

The committee has been working since May to solve safety concerns and issues including sanitation, parking, ecology, engineering, and infrastructure that inconvenience residents, motorists, and cyclists in one of Salt Lake County's most scenic and heavily used canyons. Members of the committee will be available for interviews after the presentation.
