Dear **Property Tax Relief Recipient**:

Enclosed is your 2017 Salt Lake County Property Tax Relief application(s). This mailing includes the tax relief programs for which you previously applied.

In total, we have five relief programs. Three of the five have an income limit and are related to age, being indigent, or a hardship. The other two are for veterans or the blind. If you believe you may be eligible for additional relief programs please contact us.

If you are applying for a **Tax Abatement** (*which includes Circuit Breaker, Indigent, and Hardship*), please complete Sections 1-7 on the enclosed application, but if you apply only for Circuit Breaker, you do not need to complete Section 6.

If you are a **service connected Disabled Veteran**, you are receiving the 2017 Veterans Exemption Application either because you are a new applicant, or you have used a portion of your exemption in prior years for the reduction of taxes and fees on personal property or motor vehicles. If you are a new applicant, please provide a copy of your most recent certification letter from the Department of Veteran's Affairs. If you have any changes that would affect your exemption, we require a new application to be submitted.

Please complete and return your application(s) and supporting documents as soon as possible to ensure prompt processing of your 2017 property tax relief. **The deadline for filing the 2017 applications is September 1** except as provided in Utah Code Section 59-2-1105(2) and 59-2-1106(2).
