


# SIZE SALT LAKE FOREIGN-BORN POPULATION

## **EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT**




- FOREIGN-BORN NATIVES

## **DID YOU KNOW?**

- 48,777 (37%) residents are naturalized citizens and eligible to vote.
- **8,841** (57%) foreign-born arrivals from 2010 to 2013 were Asian.
- 10,359 foreign-born students are enrolled in a college or university.
- **63,559** (48%) residents are of child bearing age (25-44).
- · A full-time, year-round, foreign-born male employee makes \$19,037 less annually than his native counterpart.
