Mayor McAdams Continues Open Door Policy By Declaring His Cabinet Meetings Open To The Public

Salt Lake County, UT—Salt Lake County Mayor Ben McAdams says the business of the mayor's office is open to the public and the media, including meetings of his cabinet. McAdams today signed an executive order to that effect.

"I believe in not only 'talking the talk' but also 'walking the walk' when it comes to openness and transparency in government," said McAdams. "That's why I'm issuing this order to ensure that my monthly cabinet meeting is open to anyone from the public or the media that would like to attend."

McAdams noted that the Mayor's Cabinet does not vote on matters and has no authority to make binding decisions. But it is used to discuss and provide advice and recommendations regarding executive branch projects and plans and coordination among departments. Those in attendance include the Mayor, the Deputy Mayor, Department Directors and other members of the Mayor's staff.

McAdams said his cabinet meets on the first and third Mondays of the month, at 8 a.m., in the Salt Lake County Government Center, N-4500.
