Adaptive Inclusion Aide:

Adaptive Inclusion Aides act as a one-on-one or small group support staff for patrons with disabilities participating in the Kearns Recreation Center childcare program. They assist in planning and facilitating recreation programs for people with disabilities and ensure the safety of the facility and program.

Morning and/or afternoon shifts are available. Successful applicants must be at least 21 years old, be able to pass a criminal background check and be willing to work with individuals of all ability levels.

Job responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Provides assistance to individuals with disabilities in child care programs.
- Helps ensure children with disabilities are included in daily child care programming.
- Attends job specific trainings.
- Conducts and actively participates in scheduled recreational activities.
- Oversees and monitors all indoor and outdoor areas as assigned.
- Supervises classroom activities.
- Provides effective customer service in working with patrons and participants.
- Monitors safety of facility and program environment.
- Assists in maintaining and controlling inventory of supplies and equipment.
- Enforces rules and regulations of facility, programs, activities, and events.
- Assists in keeping accurate records of attendance, inventory, and maintenance and janitorial supplies.

Large Van Driver:

Drivers transport children to and from schools in the Kearns / West Jordan area and on field trips in the Salt Lake Valley. Morning, noon and afternoon shifts are available. Successful applicants must be at least 21 years old, be able to pass a criminal background check, and possess a valid driver's license. We provide all other training.

Summer Camp Teacher:

The Kearns Recreation Center is now hiring for our childcare summer camp. Summer camp teachers work directly with the children in the classrooms and on field trips providing supervision and directing various planned activities. Full-day and other various shifts are available. Successful applicants must be at least 16 years old and be able to pass a criminal background check. We provide all other training.
