In addition, it is where the Council takes action on Zoning related items. Action may be taken by the Council on any item listed on the agenda which may include: approval, approval with conditions, denial, continuance or recommendation to other bodies as applicable.

Ordinances –

30386 - A Public Hearing will be held to consider eliminating the Mixed Development “MD-1” zone from the Zoning Ordinances of Millcreek. This zone has not been used in Millcreek and therefore is not needed to conduct City business. 30388 - A Public Hearing will be held to consider amendments to the Millcreek Code of Ordinances Section 19.82.020 – Definitions- with respect to the definition of “Existing Billboards “ to change the date used to determine existing billboards from “prior to May 18, 2004,” to “existing as of December 27, 2013,” and limiting the boundaries for existing billboards to the boundaries of the city as it was incorporated and Section 19.82.185B - Off-premises signs— Cap on Number of Off-Premises Signs to change the date used to limit the number of off-premise signs from May 18, 2004, to December 27, 2013 and limiting the boundaries for the number of off- premise signs to the boundaries of the city as it was incorporated.
