## ELIGIBLE VOTERS ENCOURAGED TO RETURN BALLOTS FOR 2021 MUNICIPAL PRIMARY ELECTIONS

The Salt Lake County Election Division is encouraging all eligible voters to complete and return their mail-in ballots for the 2021 Municipal Primary Election by Election Day on August 10<sup>th</sup>. The Primary Elections only apply to voters residing in **Herriman, Murray, Taylorsville (Council District #5), West Jordan, and West Valley City**. All other municipalities either do not require a primary election or are participating in ranked choice voting and will not be voting until the General Election in November.

Ballots can be returned in one of the following three ways:

- By depositing the postage-paid envelope into any U.S. Post Office mailbox. Ballots returned by mail must be **postmarked by August 9<sup>th</sup>** (the day before Election Day) to be valid.
- By dropping ballots in one of the 19 drive-up ballot drop boxes in Salt Lake County. Drop boxes will be open until 8 p.m. on Election Day. A list of drop boxes is included in ballot instructions and at [www.got-vote.org](http://www.got-vote.org).
- By returning ballots to an Election Day Vote Center during polling hours (7:00 am – 8:00 pm).

A list of candidates and a link to candidate profiles is available on the Salt Lake County Election Division website, along with information on how to vote in-person on August 10<sup>th</sup> for those unable to vote by mail.
