DEADLINE TO REGISTER TO VOTE AND RECEIVE A MAIL-IN BALLOT IS OCTOBER 22ND, 2021

The 2021 Municipal General Elections will be conducted mainly by mail in Salt Lake County. Only active registered voters were sent a ballot. Eligible voters have until 5:00 PM on Friday, October 22nd to register to vote and be sent a mail-in ballot. **NOTE:** Voters who are already registered to vote in Salt Lake County, but have moved within the County, may update their address without re-registering to vote. They may call or email and update their address so a ballot can be mailed to them.

For those wishing to register, there are several ways to do so:

- The most convenient way to register is to visit www.got-vote.org, select the “Register to Vote” link, and follow the instructions to register online.
- A PDF voter registration form can also be accessed at that link. Voters may complete and sign the form. They may either return a paper or digital copy to the Salt Lake County Election Division for processing.
- Those who need register in-person may do so at the Election Division (2001 S State Street, South Building, S1-200.)

Additionally, Utah allows for same-day registration. Eligible voters may register to vote at any of the early voting or election day vote centers. (Identification AND proof of residency is required for same-day registration.)

The Salt Lake County Election Division encourages everyone to register as soon as possible to receive their mail-in ballot and exercise this important constitutional right.
