

COVID Equity Grant

Questions and Answers

Question 1: Are we allowed to partner with other organizations for this grant?

Answer: Yes, you can partner with other organizations. It would need to be set up as a Grantee/Subgrantee relationship as follows: There would need to be one organization that submits the application on behalf of the partnership. This organization would need to meet all eligibility requirements. If awarded funds, the applying organization would receive all the funding and then make subgrants to any partners. The grant recipient organization would need to establish formal agreements with each subgrantee that include the following language:

Subgrantee/subcontractor understands that the subcontract/subgrant is between the grantee and the subgrantee/subcontractor and is funded by Salt Lake County. Subgrantee/subcontractor further agrees that at all times during the agreement, subgrantee/subcontractor will comply with all anti-discrimination, employment, and drug-free workplace laws and all other applicable federal and state constitutions, and other applicable local laws, rules, codes, orders, and regulations. Subgrantee/subcontractor must comply with any audits, reviews, and requests for information/documentation from Salt Lake County Health Department.

Question 2: Is there a minimum or maximum amount to be requested for this grant?

Answer: You may request up to \$50,000. There is no required minimum amount.

Question 3: What are some examples of allowable expenses and percentages?

Answer: A sample of acceptable expenses for the grant would include staff salaries, supplies, travel (mileage), communication efforts, incentives. Percentages for each are expected to be reasonable and practical compared to the requested amount of money for each.
