

FACILITY IMPROVEMENT FEE INFORMATION

Beginning January 1st, 2020, Salt Lake County Parks and Recreation will implement a Facility Improvement Fee (FIF) to select offerings in each section of our division. The FIF is a new tool to enhance facilities and/or amenities by building a dedicated fund to be used for smaller-to-medium scale capital improvement projects.

What does it pay for?

The FIF funds will be used for smaller-to-medium scale capital improvement projects, for example: new paint, lights, flooring, etc. These investments will help enhance our patron experience.

What doesn't it pay for?

Larger-scale capital improvement projects like HVAC, roofing, pool boilers, etc. will not be purchased using FIF funds. These projects will continue to be funded through other sources.
