

Thank you for your interest in becoming a Salt Lake County Senior Center presenter. The mission of Active Aging is to provide seniors the opportunity for learning, socializing, volunteering, and wellness. This is accomplished by offering programming and activities that complement existing services and foster on-going engagement that supports independence, dignity, health, recreation, volunteerism and access to resources.

Senior Center programming includes presentations and courses offered by non-governmental entities. Salt Lake County Senior Centers pursue partnerships with organizations and individuals who have knowledge and expertise in topical areas relevant to aging and of interest to older adults in order to provide such presentations and courses. Presentations approved through this process are considered Salt Lake County programming.

Basic Information

Approved presentations and classes will be approved for all 16 Salt Lake County operated senior centers. Interest, demand and frequency of presentation and classes may vary according to center.

Application Criteria

All programs must be open to all seniors. Classes may have material fees; however, fees will be paid to the Senior Center and presenters may submit invoices for class materials.

Presentations should be aging related and relevant to seniors in the following categories:

- Access to resources;
- Fitness and exercise;
- Health and wellness;
- Recreation, art, and music;
- Education; and
- Volunteerism.

Presenter Request Announcements will be posted seeking proposals for specific presentations and classes. Proposals may only be submitted when a request for proposal related to the topic is posted.

Selection Process

The selection process for presentations and classes is as follows:

- a. Interested presenters submit proposal and presentation materials
- b. Presenter Selection Committee will review proposals and materials.
 - I. If Presenter Selection Committee has questions regarding a proposal or materials, a presenter interview may be scheduled.
- c. The Presenter Selection Committee will score each proposal and recommend selected proposals for approval.
- d. Final approved presenters must complete and sign the Presenter Agreement before presenting at any Salt Lake County Senior Center.
- e. Approved presenters will be added to an approved list for all Salt Lake County Senior Centers to access when scheduling presentations.
 - I. There are no guarantees that a selected program or presenter will, subsequently, be selected or scheduled by Senior Centers.
