OLDER ADULTS & CORONAVIRUS

Older adults age 60+ are at a higher risk for contracting COVID-19 (coronavirus). Those who are at a higher risk of getting sick are encouraged to take social distancing measures to protect themselves and others. As a result, Salt Lake County will temporarily alter the procedures for delivering Meals on Wheels.

MEALS ON WHEELS DELIVERIES

- Meals on Wheels drivers will continue to deliver your meals.
- Meals will be put into a bag and placed on the door handle of your home.
- The Driver will wait at least 10 feet away until you get the bag with your meal.
- If you don't answer the door the driver will call you to ensure you receive your meal.
- If you have instructions for the driver to enter your home they will still follow those instructions.
- Aging & Adult Services will be contacting you by phone to check in while COVID-19 delivery procedures are in place.
