

The Community Partners Grant Program

September 18, 2020

Salt Lake County is launching a new COVID-19 recovery program supporting critical services to the community through one-time grants in four key areas:

- Housing and Homeless Services
- Education and Childcare
- Business Training and Support
- Arts and Culture

The Community Partners Grant Program will support new services, related staffing, and COVID-19 costs, incurred between July 1 and Dec. 30, 2020. Grant amounts will be determined individually based on documentation and requirements in the application.

Eligibility

To be eligible, organizations must meet ALL of the following:

- Be a 501(c)(3) or 501(c)(6) for at least 5 years
- Be an industry listed in the key areas outlined and impacted by COVID-19
- Be based in Salt Lake County and directly provide services to Salt Lake County residents
- Provide projects directly related to programming due to COVID-19
