### **5:40 pm County Report (Jared Stewart)**

- No project updates from SL County Engineering or SL County Parks and Recreation

### **5:45 pm Bike Utah Funding Request (Chris Wiltsie, Bike Utah)**

- Chris presented on the concept and plans for a pop-up project (tactical urbanism) in South Salt Lake located on Main street at the S-Line (Parley's Trail).
- The project will include a mural, a curb cut, painted bicycle lanes, and other possible features to be determined.
- Examples of similar projects that Chris has worked on were included
- Committee discussed the proposal, cost, budget, and asked Chris questions.
- Committee determined that this project fits with it's goals and has wanted to participate in a tactical urbanism project for some time.
- Chris plans to implement the project in October.
- The committee unanimously approved the funding request for \$4,000 to Bike Utah for the project (motion by Alex Parker and second from Mike Mikhalev).

- Alex provided a review of this topic—that SLCBAC has an opportunity to be a voice for the cycling community. Alex solicited members to help him brainstorm this topic and will set up a separate meeting offline with those individuals.

### **6:20 pm Active Transportation Reference Sheet (Jared Stewart)**

- Jared shared a reference sheet created to help Salt Lake County municipalities be aware of funding resources available for projects related to Active Transportation.

- Funding sources are available from Wasatch Front Regional Council, the Utah Department of Transportation, and each municipalities own allocation of fourth quarter sales tax revenue.
- Travis brought up that the Safe Sidewalk Program is separate from the Safe Routes Utah program. Jared will update the reference sheet to reflect both programs
- Jared will share this reference sheet with SLCBAC and partners.
- SLCBAC members are invited to share this reference sheet with the municipalities where they live.
