**NOTICE REGARDING SALT LAKE COUNTY'S PUBLIC HEALTH ORDER &
PUBLIC ACCESS TO THE COUNTY GOVERNMENT CENTER:**

Due to the ongoing public health emergency related to the COVID-19 pandemic, public access to the Salt Lake County Government Center has been limited to appointment only on the orders of the Salt Lake County Mayor. More information about public access to the County Government Center and other County facilities can be found at slco.org/covid-19/county-closures/.

Consistent with Salt Lake County Council Resolution 5714, approved March 24, 2020, Salt Lake County Council is conducting its meetings electronically. Because public access to the Salt Lake County Government Center is limited – and in light of state and local public health orders prohibiting mass gatherings – the Council cannot currently provide physical space or facilities for members of the public to attend its meetings in person.

Members of the public are invited to participate in the Council's meetings electronically. **Agendas, audio live-Streams and recordings, and meeting minutes can be accessed at slco.legistar.com**. The Council will continue to broadcast a live-stream of its meetings on Facebook Live, which can be accessed at <http://www.facebook.com/SLCoCouncil/>

The Council will continue to receive citizen public input at the beginning of its meetings. The meetings will be conducted via Webex Events. Citizens wishing to comment must access the meeting using the Webex link provided on the meeting's agenda – accessible at least 24 hours prior to the scheduled meeting – by the beginning of the Citizen Public Input portion of the meeting. Comments will be limited to three minutes per individual unless otherwise approved by the Council. If a citizen is unable to attend the meeting via Webex, they may email their comments to councilwebex@slco.org by a time specified on the meeting's agenda to have those comments distributed to the Council and to have those comments read into the record at the appropriate time.

The Council will continue to publish its agendas on the Utah Open Public Meeting Act's website (Utah.gov/pmn/index.html) and on its webpage (slco.legistar.com). The Council encourages members of the public to observe all state and local public health orders and to stay safe and stay home.
