

Use this document to triage incoming clients for monkeypox vaccine and/or testing. Do not share this form with the public; this is **for internal use only**.

Eligibility criteria:

1. Are you a member of the MSM (men who have sex with men) community?
 - a. Yes – **Meets eligibility criteria, continue to triage questions**
 - b. No – **Does not meet eligibility criteria. Explain that they are not eligible for vaccination at this time, and they can check the SLCoHD website for updates about expanded eligibility. Do not proceed to vaccination.**

Triage questions:

2. Do you currently have an undiagnosed rash or any lesions that look like pimples or blisters on your body?
 - a. Yes, I have a rash or lesions – **Not eligible for vaccination but should be directed to testing. Explain that they should get tested before they can be vaccinated. If their test results are negative, they can get vaccine at that time.**
 - b. No, I **do not** have a rash or lesions – **Proceed to book vaccination appointment**

3. In the last 14 days, have you had any close contact with someone who has been diagnosed with monkeypox?
Close contact includes oral, anal, and vaginal sex or touching the genitals of someone with monkeypox; hugging, massaging, and kissing; prolonged face-to-face contact; or touching fabrics and objects during sex that were used by a person with monkeypox and that have not been disinfected, such as bedding, towels, and sex toys.
 - a. Yes, in the past 14 days I have had close contact with someone who has monkeypox – **Eligible for vaccination if asymptomatic.** Ask them if it is okay to have an epidemiologist follow up with them about their contact. If yes, send name and contact information to Ryan Chatelain (rchatelain@slco.org) and Kylie Sage (ksage@slco.org)
 - b. No, in the past 14 days I **have not** had close contact with someone who has monkeypox – **Proceed to book vaccination appointment if asymptomatic**
