

EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 2017-5

**DESIGNATION, AUTHORIZATION AND DEPUTIZATION OF
CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICERS FOR APPEALS ON BEHALF OF SALT LAKE COUNTY**

WHEREAS, Section 17-53-316 of the Utah Code grants authority to the Salt Lake County Mayor, as County Executive, to issue executive orders to establish and implement an executive policy and practice;

WHEREAS, Section 63G-2-401, et seq. of the Utah Code was recently amended to change GRAMA request appeals from the County Council to the Chief Administrative Officer for the County. This statutory change necessitates the need to designate Chief Administrative Officers for Appeals.

WHEREAS, because of the volume and time sensitive nature of the GRAMA request appeals the Salt Lake County Chief Administrative Officer is required to review, it is in the best interest of the County for the Salt Lake County Mayor to designate, authorize and deputize other individuals to serve as Chief Administrative Officers for Appeals;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Ben McAdams, Mayor of Salt Lake County, State of Utah, pursuant to the powers vested in me by the laws of the State of Utah, do hereby order the following:

1. That for all Salt Lake County GRAMA request appeals, except for those involving the Sheriff's Office, Megan Hillyard, Director of Administrative Services, is hereby designated, authorized and deputized as Chief Administrative Officer for Appeals.
2. That for all Salt Lake County Sheriff GRAMA request appeals, the Administrative Captain is hereby designated, authorized and deputized as Chief Administrative Officer for Appeals.


This Executive Order is effective upon execution.
