- 40 home on-ice activities (these are practices and games at our home arena. Does not include tournament games or friendlies on other's ice)
- 4-5 tournaments, 2 of which will be out of State
- Practices are Tuesday/Thursday evenings at the Salt Lake City Sports Complex. (Saturday activities such as home or away friendlies are anticipated).
- Cost is \$1200.00, which includes game jerseys (2), game socks, practice jersey, banquet and award. Payments are split into: Deposit, then 3 payments due throughout the winter/spring.
