

## Ice Rink Rules – Effective Tuesday, September 22, 2020

**GENERAL ICE RINK RULES – Patron and employee safety is our first priority. All rules will be strictly enforced.**

**Private rentals, drop in hockey and public skate sessions are not available.**

**Time is allowed between each session to clean touch points in the facility.**

**Patrons who violate rules may be asked to leave the facility and forfeit the right to attend future sessions.**

**Pro Shop, concessions and vending machines are not available.**

**Refunds – 24 hour notice must be given to cancel and receive a credit.**

### Reservations:

- Reservation and payment must be made in advance on facility website or by calling the facility.
- Sessions are one hour and vary by facility.
- Do not make reservations for anyone other than yourself.

### Arriving and Checking In:

- Skaters arrive 10 minutes prior to reserved session and will check in at designated area per facility.
- Only one parent/guardian (no children) will be allowed per skater at their reserved time.
- Parent will sit in a designated area in the bleachers during the session following social distancing.

### Lobby Area: (social distancing must be followed at all times)

- Skaters must use designated bench to put on and remove skates.
- Warm ups or stretching must take place outside before checking in and entering the facility.
- Locker rooms, off ice training, skate and helmet rentals are not available.
- No gathering in the facility.

### On the Ice: (additional information provided below for Freestyle and Stick and Puck)

- No food or beverages are allowed on the ice, except plastic water bottles in a designated area.
- Skaters shall be alert as to other skaters at all times and yield to slower skaters.
- Skaters must immediately leave after session time has ended.

### After Your Ice Session:

- Skaters must immediately remove skates and exit the facility within 5 minutes after their session.
- If skaters are registered for two sessions back to back, skater must sit at their designated bench in the lobby until the next session is available.

## **FREESTYLE SESSION (10 ft. social distancing must be followed.) – Max 5 coaches included in 20 skater limit**

- No more than 20 skaters per one hour session.
- Only one skater at a time allowed in the music box.
- Rink boards marked every 10 feet for skater to place tissue box, water bottle and jacket, etc.

## **STICK & PUCK SESSION (10 ft. social distancing must be followed.) – Max 5 coaches included in 20 skater limit**

- No more than 20 skaters, including goalies per one hour session. Goalies must pay each for session.
- No team reservations for a session.
- No more than 4 skaters per net. Be courteous and rotate, if only one goalie is present.
- Scrimmages will not be allowed, including small area games, 1 vs 1, and puck possession games
- Required Equipment: helmet, skates, stick, gloves, and puck for all ages. Hockey facemask for anyone under 18 yrs. old.
