SALT LAKE VALLEY LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICE AREA

A RESOLUTION OF THE SALT LAKE VALLEY LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICE AREA BOARD OF TRUSTEES STATING ITS INTENT TO LEVY A TAX RATE THAT EXCEEDS THE CERTIFIED TAX RATE, THE DOLLAR AMOUNT OF THE TAX REVENUE THAT WOULD BE GENERATED BY THE PROPOSED INCREASE, THE PURPOSE FOR THE ADDITIONAL TAX REVENUE AND THE APPROXIMATE PERCENTAGE INCREASE IN THE PROPERTY TAX REVENUE BASED ON THE PROPOSED INCREASE

WHEREAS, section 59-2-919 of the Utah Code requires that before the Salt Lake Valley Law Enforcement Service Area (SLVLESA) considers to levy a tax rate that exceeds the certified tax rate, it must, within 14 or more days before the regular general election, at a duly noticed public meeting, state that it intends to levy a tax rate that exceeds its certified tax rate, the dollar amount of and purpose for the additional tax revenue and the approximate percentage increase in the tax revenue based on the proposed increase; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 17B-1-1003 of the Utah Code, a report on the proposed tax increase was presented to the legislative bodies of all members of SLVLESA including the Salt Lake County Council and the legislative bodies of all members approved the proposed property tax increase for consideration by the SLVLESA Board of Trustees subject to compliance with the notice and public hearing requirements under 59-2-919 of the Utah Code; and

WHEREAS, the SLVLESA Board of Trustees wants to make a statement consistent with section 59-2-919 of the Utah Code.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the SLVLESA Board of Trustees as follows:

1. SLVLESA intends to levy a tax rate that exceeds its certified tax rate.
2. The estimated dollar amount of the additional tax revenue that will be generated by the proposed tax increase is \$481,000.
3. In 2016, the SLVLESA Board of Trustees adopted a five-year strategic plan that includes incremental property tax increases to protect the solvency and stability of its fund balance. Without the property tax increases, the fund balance would have been depleted by 2018. Consistent with the strategic plan, the property tax increases were approved and implemented for 2017 and 2018, The strategic plan provides for a 3% property tax increase for 2019. The additional revenue is essential to fund the increase in costs under the Unified Police Department contract due to needed additional police resources, inflation and cost of living adjustments, a change in the pooled services formula, capital needs, Kearns precinct building replacement, an

increase in expenses if there is a Brighton incorporation and the need to provide new law enforcement services.

4. SLVLESA intends to budget, for 2019, a 3% increase in property tax revenues,


