Scope and Content Note

Contains the burial records for people buried in county cemeteries. Books include columns for the following information, though not every entry includes all of the categories: date entered, name of deceased, date of birth, place of birth, date of death, place of death, cause of death, name of undertaker, private citizen or honorably discharged soldier, name of nearest relative, height, weight, color of eyes, complexion, occupation, where buried, and when paid. The second book, which starts in April 1924, also includes an amount paid column.

Many of the columns are usually left blank, including the height, weight, color of eyes, and complexion columns. The entries are far more complete for the earlier years, later years only consistently list date entered, name of deceased, date of death, name of undertaker, private citizen/honorably discharged soldier, amount paid, where buried, and when paid.

The City Cemetery appears most commonly, but other cemeteries are also listed, including; Mill Creek, Mt. Olivet, Jewish Cemetery, Cottonwood Cemetery, South Cottonwood, Midvale, Brigham, Murray, and Wasatch Lawn.
