History Note

The position of Salt Lake County Treasurer was created in 1852, (Utah Code Annotated, 1876, title 4, chapter 4, p. 130). The mission of the Salt Lake County Treasurer is to efficiently administer the property tax billing, collection and property tax relief programs for Salt Lake County, and professionally and prudently manage all monies belonging to the County and others as directed by law. The primary responsibility of the Salt Lake County Treasurer is to collect county fees and taxes. The treasurer falls under the administration of the county commissioners (known as the county court prior to statehood).

Scope and Content Note

Index to Mining Claims, Salt Lake County Treasurer, 1950 – 1959 (contains 1950 – 1961).

Index to Mining Claims, Salt Lake County Treasurer, 1962 – 1974 (skips 1974 and lists 1975). These indexes list the name of the mining claim, the patent number, and have two numbers entered for each year. The numbers may refer to a book, page, and line, but no records currently found match this index.

Index to Patented Mining Claims, 1898.

Graves' Printed Index adapted to record mining claims. This index lists the names of mine claims, the district, and two numbers which are probably page and line numbers, and the name(s) of the owner(s).

Index to Mines, 1910 – 1922 (ends in 1918)

This index lists the name of mining claims and the district. There are two numbers for each year, and a letter is written above each year that probably is a reference to a nonexistent book (i.e. Book I, J, F, and M).

Index to Mining Claims, Salt Lake County Treasurer, 1918-1927.

This index lists the name of the mining claim, the patent number, the district (abbreviated) and two numbers under each year which probably refer to a book. This index, within each alphabetical grouping, is also grouped under mining districts (e.g. West Mountain, Little Cottonwood, Big Cottonwood, and Hot Springs).

Index to Mining Claims, Salt Lake County Treasurer, 1928-1938.

This index lists the name of the mining claim, the patent number, and two numbers which probably refer to page and line number of a nonexistent volume. Each year has a number written above it which may refer to the nonexistent volume (e.g. 20 and 21).
