Description: This series is a history collection turned over to the Hansen Planetarium by Mrs. Gail Plummer.

Gail Plummer was the Director of the Salt Lake City Library Board in 1964, when the City Library (originally housed in the Planetarium building) moved to its location on 200 East 500 South. Mr. Plummer wanted to find a use for the empty City Library building, and thought that it should house a Planetarium. When Mrs. George T. Hansen contacted the Library Board Director and expressed concern over the fate of the old building, Mr. Plummer shared his wish to have a Planetarium established. Mrs. George T. Hansen provided the money to fund Mr. Plummer's idea.
