The 2017 Municipal General Elections, U.S. Representative District #3 Special Election, Metro Township Elections, Local District Elections, City of West Jordan Proposition 10, City of West Jordan Aquatic and Recreation Center Bond Election, Canyons School District Bond Election and the Granite School District Bond Election are being conducted mainly by mail, for which registered voters in Salt Lake County were mailed a ballot. In conjunction with vote by mail, public notice is hereby given that vote centers will be open on **Election Day, Tuesday, November 7, 2017** from 7:00 am until 8:00 pm. Vote Centers are offered for voters who need the ADA accommodations available with electronic voting machines, did not receive a ballot in the mail, misplaced their ballot, or need to vote in person. All eligible registered voters may cast a ballot at **any one of the Vote Centers**, but they must **provide valid identification**.

ID REQUIREMENT

Utah law requires voters to present a valid form of identification each time they vote at the polls. For a complete list of acceptable identification, please visit the County Clerk's website listed below.

QUALIFICATIONS TO VOTE IN GENERAL ELECTION

In order to vote, an individual must be 18 years of age or older on Election Day, a citizen of the United States, a resident of Utah for at least 30 days immediately before the election and registered to vote in Salt Lake County.

BALLOT DROP LOCATIONS

Voters who did not return their ballot by mail postmarked by the **day before Election Day**, may drop their voted ballot at **any one** of the following Vote Centers on Election Day during polling hours (**7:00 am – 8:00 pm**). Also, there are **17 drive-thru ballot drop boxes** throughout the county that are open 24/7 where voters may drop their ballot until **8:00 pm** on Election Day. NOTICE OF AUDIT

The Salt Lake County Clerk's Office will conduct a one-percent audit of election results on Tuesday, November 14th, at 9:00 am. The audit compares the votes counted on a random sampling of voting machines to the corresponding voter verified paper trails. It also includes an audit of a sampling of paper vote-by-mail ballots. This audit is open to public observation and will be conducted at the Salt Lake County Government Center, 2001 South State Street, South Building, Room S1-950, Salt Lake City, Utah.
