VACANT OFFICE TO BE FILLED AT THE 2018 NOVEMBER GENERAL ELECTION

I, Sherrie Swensen, Salt Lake County Clerk, hereby give notice that a vacancy exists in the office of **Salt Lake County Council Member for Council District Four**. The remaining two years of the unexpired term will be filled by popular vote during the General Election to be held on **Tuesday, November 6, 2018**.

CANDIDATE FILING PERIOD

- The county central committee of each registered political party may submit a candidate for the office by summarily certifying the name of one candidate to the County Clerk for placement on the General Election ballot.
- Unaffiliated candidates may obtain a position on the General Election ballot by first submitting a certificate of nomination, along with a completed petition containing the signatures of 300 registered voters residing within Salt Lake County Council District Four, to the County Clerk's Office in accordance with section 20A-9-502, Utah Code Ann. (2018). Then, after the certificate of nomination has been certified, executed, and acknowledged by the County Clerk, the candidate must appear in person at the Office of the County Clerk between **Friday, July 27th - Thursday, August 2nd** to file for candidacy formally and pay the filing fee.

The County Clerk's Office is open weekdays from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm and is located at 2001 South State Street, South Building, First Floor, S1-200.
