

OFFICIAL PUBLIC NOTICE 2017 PRIMARY ELECTIONS SALT LAKE COUNTY

The 2017 Primary Elections are being conducted mainly by mail for which eligible registered voters in Salt Lake County were mailed a ballot. In conjunction with vote by mail, public notice is hereby given that vote centers will be open on **Election Day, Tuesday, August 15, 2017** from 7:00 am until 8:00 pm. Vote centers are available for voters who need the **ADA** accommodations offered with electronic voting machines, did not receive a ballot in the mail, misplaced their ballot, or want to vote in person. All eligible registered voters may vote at **any one of the vote centers** and must **provide valid identification**.

ID REQUIREMENT

Utah law requires voters to present a valid form of identification each time they vote at the polls. For a complete list of acceptable identification, please visit the County Clerk's website at: www.GOT-VOTE.org.

QUALIFICATIONS TO VOTE IN PRIMARY ELECTIONS

In order to vote, a person must be 18 years of age or older on Election Day, a citizen of the United States, a resident of Utah for at least 30 days immediately before the election.

PARTISAN PRIMARY ELECTIONS

The Governor called a special election to fill the Third Congressional District seat vacated by Jason Chaffetz. While other political parties selected their candidate, a primary is required for the Republican Party to choose their nominee for the Third Congressional District seat. Partisan primary elections are a function of the political parties to nominate candidates to represent the political party in the November General Election. The Republican Party has chosen to close their primary election so only voters affiliated with their party may participate. **(NOTE: The Third Congressional District only includes a portion of Salt Lake County.)**

NON-PARTISAN PRIMARY ELECTIONS

In certain areas of the County, there are non-partisan municipal primary elections. **Non-partisan elections are open to all voters regardless of party affiliation.**

BALLOT DROP LOCATIONS (*Walk and drop*)

Voters who did not return their ballot by mail (postmarked by the **day before Election Day**), may drop off their voted ballot at **any one** of the following vote centers on Election Day during polling hours (7:00 am – 8:00 pm). For a list of other ballot drop locations, visit the County Clerk website.

NOTICE OF AUDIT

The Salt Lake County Clerk's Office will conduct a one-percent audit of the election results on Tuesday, August 22nd at 9:00 am. During the audit, the votes counted on a random sampling of voting machines are compared to the corresponding voter verified paper trails. Also included is an audit of a sampling of paper vote-by-mail ballots. This audit is open to public observation and will be conducted at the Salt Lake County Government Center, 2001 South State Street, South Building, Room S1-950, Salt Lake City, Utah.
