

2017 GENERAL ELECTION INFORMATION

The 2017 Salt Lake County General Election is being conducted mainly by mail. Registered voters will be mailed a ballot for the November 7, 2017 election.

VOTE-BY-MAIL INFORMATION

- Ballots will be mailed the week of October 16th.
- A postage-paid return envelope will be provided.
- The affidavit on the ballot return envelope **must be signed** by the voter for their ballot to be valid.

RETURNING YOUR VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOT

- Ballots returned by mail must be **postmarked by November 6th**, the day before Election Day. (To ensure ballots are postmarked timely, they should be mailed by Saturday, November 4th.)
- Ballot drop boxes are available throughout the County and are open 24/7.
- Voters may return their ballot to a ballot drop box until 8:00 pm on Election Day. For a list of drop box locations, visit the website.
- Voters may return their voted ballot to any Vote Center on Election Day (7:00 am – 8:00 pm).

IN-PERSON VOTING *(ID is required for those who vote in person. For a list of valid ID, visit the website.)*

- In-Office/Early Voting will be available at the County Clerk's Office (2001 S State Street, S1-200) weekdays from October 9th - November 6th (8:00 am – 5:00 pm).
- Early voting locations throughout the County will be open on Wednesdays, Thursdays & Fridays (Oct. 25, 26, 27 & Nov. 1, 2, 3). For a list of locations and hours, visit the website.
- On Election Day (November 7), Vote Centers will be open from 7:00 am – 8:00 pm for voters who need the amenities of the electronic voting machines, misplaced their ballot, or otherwise need to vote in person. Visit the website for a list of vote centers.

NOTE: Salt Lake County registered voters may vote at any one of the early voting locations or vote centers regardless of where they reside within the County.

REGISTER TO VOTE OR UPDATE YOUR VOTER REGISTRATION ADDRESS

- Register online at www.vote.utah.gov by October 31st (a Utah driver license or State ID card is required for online voter registration).
- Register in person by October 31st at the County Clerk's Office.
- Update your address by phone or email if you have been previously registered to vote in Salt Lake County and have moved within the County.
