

Rules and Regulations

1. No refund will be made on canceled reservations.
2. Reservations may not be transferred to third parties. The Responsible Party information on the application **must** be the person who will be utilizing the Yurt. Please be aware that the responsible party is the person who will be contacted to verify the dates assigned to them.
3. No motorized vehicles are allowed beyond the winter gate at Maple Grove.
4. Up to 2 dogs are allowed at the yurt during the months of **January** and **March** only.
5. Dogs must always be leashed in picnic areas, parking lots, roads and any developed areas. Dogs may be off-leash on odd-numbered days on the upper trails only. Owners are responsible to dispose of dog waste properly.
6. A maximum of 8 people are allowed.
7. Fires need to be extinguished with water at the end of your stay. All ash needs to be removed from the stove and put into the ash can. It is unlawful to leave anything burning.
8. Check in time is 1 pm. Check out time is 12 noon the next day. Please leave the yurt clean.
9. Split wood for the stove is provided outside on the wood stand. Please restock inside wood supply for the next party before leaving.
10. It is your responsibility to shovel snow away from the yurt door and restroom doors during heavy storms (snow shovel is provided). Maintenance may not be available for a couple of days.
11. There is no garbage service in Mill Creek Canyon. Please "pack it in, pack it out." Do not leave food or drinks for others.
12. RESPONSIBILITY FOR BREAKAGE OF OR DAMAGE TO THE PROPERTY DURING USE BY THIS GROUP WILL REST WITH THE RESPONSIBLE PERSON OR PERSONS.

The U.S. Forest Service has published a Big Water Yurt flyer. The flyer describes what facilities are at the yurt and what you need to bring to the yurt. The flyer also contains other useful and safety information.

You, as the Responsible Party, must pick up the key to the yurt from the Parks office, leave a \$200 deposit check and sign the Forest Service terms and conditions permit:

- * The Parks office is located at 3383 South 300 East (in South Salt Lake)
- * The Parks office is open Monday through Friday from 8 am to 5 pm except on the following County holidays:
 - Thursday, November 23, 2017 and Friday, November 24, 2017
 - Monday, December 25, 2017
 - Monday, January 1, 2018
 - Monday, January 15, 2018
 - Monday, February 19, 2018
- * You may come to the Parks office on the morning of your reservation or on the previous business day. If your reservation is on a weekend or a Monday holiday then be sure to come to our office the preceding Friday.
- * The \$200 deposit must be in the form of a check. Cash will be accepted as a deposit if absolutely necessary. Upon return of the key, your deposit will be returned to you.
