

Lifeguards Wanted:

Get paid to train!

Join the Salt Lake County Parks and Recreation team in the prestigious role of Lifeguard! *Not only will you have an envious summer (or yearlong) job, we will pay you for your training.

Just follow these simple steps:

1. **Choose a [pool](#) where you would like to work:**
2. **Contact the aquatics coordinator at that pool:**
click on the link to the pool, click on the “contact” button on the left side of the screen, then click on the e-mail link by the aquatics coordinator’s name.
3. **Set up an interview and pre-test time with the aquatics coordinator:**
Bring your swimming suit to this interview. You’ll need to pass the pre-test before getting hired to take the class. The pre-test is: 50 yards fast swimming with head above water, 50 yards fast swimming with a rescue tube, 1 minute of treading water using only your legs, and retrieving a 10-pound object from the bottom of the deep end of the pool.
4. **The aquatics coordinator will help you through the hiring process and set you up with a training class.**
You will start at a training wage of 7.76. Once you have successfully completed new hire training, and demonstrated the ability to be a professional lifeguard, you will be bumped up to the lifeguard wage of \$?.??.
5. **Congratulations, you are now part of an Elite group of Lifeguard Professionals!**

*At this time, Salt Lake County will only be hiring and training lifeguards who intend to work for Salt Lake County Parks and Recreation. Salt Lake County will maintain a proprietary hold on proof of certification and will release copies of certifications at the discretion of aquatics management.
