MEETING CONVENED AT NOON (lunch provided)

Welcome and Introductions

Carlton Christensen welcomed everyone and said that Mayor McAdams was excused from the meeting. Carlten asked for introductions.

Minutes from May 13, 2015 Executive Committee Meeting

- Carlton asked for a motion to approve the minutes of May 13, 2015. Motion to approve by Sim Gill. Second by Patrick Anderson. MOTION APPROVED.

Justice Reinvestment – Salt Lake County Plan

- David Litvack gave a presentation of the Justice Reinvestment Initiative (JRI Funding) and thanked Behavioral Health for all of their help.
- The presentation provided the following information:
 - The funding will come from the following two sources:
 - Pass through funding
 - County Incentive Grant
 - The proposed implementation plan for funding.
 - The continuum of programs and services.
 - Goals.
 - Pilot partners.
- David said the next step will be getting the support of the CJAC Committee and the approval of County Council.

Carlton Christensen asked for a motion to support the Justice Reinvestment Salt Lake County Plan. Motion to approve by Sim Gill. Second by Patrick Anderson. MOTION APPROVED.

CSG – Justice Center, County Systems Initiative

- Mike Thompson presented the Criminal Justice and Behavioral Health Systems Improvement Project Report. The report contained some of the following points:
 - Project history.

- Stepping Up Initiative began in May 2015 and is a national project.
- Project timeline.
- Areas examined.
- Mental illness definitions.
- Risk definitions.
- Key Findings.
- Overview and recommendations.
- Discussion of the challenges that exist if the needed policies are not in place.
- The goals of the project are:
 - Improve public safety.
 - Maximize impact of resources.
 - Improve health outcomes.
- Discussion about recommendations and timing of risk assessments. There will be more discussion with targets at the August CJAC Full Committee meeting.
- Representative Hutchings said JRI funding and resources will be available for the project.

Alternatives to Incarceration Report

- Jeannie Edens gave an update on Alternatives to Incarceration. The report shows the impact of the following programs on recidivism:
 - Jail Diversion Outreach Program
 - CORE
 - Community Response Team.
 - ATI Transportation.
- Also shown were the reduction in new charge bookings, reduction in length of stay from new charges and the impact of housing.

Other Business

- Patrick Anderson said the new Case Clearer has been hired and would like to add Veterans Court to the screenings currently done.

Carlton Christensen asked for a Motion to approve adding Veterans Court to the Case Clearer assignments. Motion to approve by Patrick Anderson. Second by Lori Bays. MOTION APPROVED.
