Salt Lake County Announces a 30 Day Public Comment Period For a Substantial Amendment to the 2018-2019 Action Plan

WHAT: Salt Lake County is accepting public comments from citizens and community organizations on the proposed change of use in funding for the 2018-19 One Year Action Plan.

WHEN: Public Comment Period: Monday, August 20th thru Wednesday, September 19th

The County's Citizen Participation Plan in accordance with the requirements of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program and HOME Investment Partnership Program, requires the public be given 30 days to comment on the proposed Substantial Amendment. Written comments will be accepted on Monday, August 20th thru Wednesday, September 19th. Information is available on the County website at www.slco.org/hcd.

- A change in use of HOME funds includes an addition of a funding for the Liberty Square rental housing project. \$200,000 of HOME funds have been committed to this affordable rental housing project located at 461 South 600 East, Salt Lake City Utah.
- The change of use includes a change in funding for "The INN Between" activity. This agency was approved for funding in the amount of \$500,000 to assist with the "Acquisition" of a new facility. This project was deemed ineligible due to the timing of the purchase, therefore the funding is being changed from "Acquisition" to "Facility Improvements" for the facility located at 1216 East 1300 South, Salt Lake City.
- The County anticipates making an application through the CDBG Section 108 Loan Guarantee Program to assist with the new Library in the Kearns area. These funds will be part of the construction of this new resource as part of the Community Campus development.

EL CONDADO DE SALT LAKE ENMIENDA SUSTANCIAL AL PLAN DE ACCIÓN DEL AÑO 2018-2019.

El Condado de Salt Lake está aceptando comentarios públicos de ciudadanos y organizaciones comunitarias sobre el cambio de uso propuesto en la financiación del Plan de Acción de Un Año 2018-2019.

El Plan de Participación Ciudadana del Condado de acuerdo con los requisitos del programa de Subsidio en Bloque de Desarrollo Comunitario (CDBG) y el Programa de Asociación de Inversión de HOME, requiere que el público tenga 30 días para comentar sobre la Enmienda Substantial. Se aceptarán comentarios por escrito el lunes, 20 de agosto hasta el miércoles, 19 de septiembre.

- Un cambio en el uso de los fondos de HOME incluye una adición de fondos para el proyecto de vivienda de alquiler en Liberty Square. Se han comprometido \$ 200,000 de los fondos de HOME para este proyecto de viviendas de alquiler asequible ubicado en 461 South 600 East, Salt Lake City Utah.
- El cambio de uso incluye un cambio en los fondos para la actividad "The INN Between". Se aprobó la financiación de esta agencia por un monto de \$ 500,000 para ayudar con la "Adquisición" de una nueva instalación. Este proyecto se consideró inelegible debido a la fecha de la compra, por lo tanto, el financiamiento se cambia de "Adquisición" a "Mejoras de la instalación" para la instalación ubicada en 1216 East 1300 South, Salt Lake City.
- El Condado anticipa hacer una solicitud a través del Programa de Garantía de Préstamo de la Sección 108 de CDBG para ayudar con la nueva biblioteca en el área de Kearns. Estos fondos serán parte de la construcción de este nuevo recurso como parte del desarrollo del Campus Comunitario.
