

Salt Lake County Homeless Point in Time Count

Wednesday, January 25 – Saturday, January 28, 2017

There are multiple opportunities and several ways to be part of the Salt Lake County Homeless Point in Time Count. The project will take place over a four-day period from Wednesday, January 25, through Saturday, January 28, 2017. For this effort, we anticipate needing upwards of 100 volunteers, most of whom will conduct surveys with persons experiencing homelessness who are living on the streets.

In the past we have had one central location as a “Home Base” for the Point In Time Count operations. This year, we will be doing a youth specific event overnight beginning on January 25th. We would also like to have a secondary “Home Base” located somewhere outside of downtown Salt Lake City. If anyone is interested in discussing this option, please let us know.

Also, there are other vital roles to the effort of the Homeless Point in Time Count, including providing in-kind or monetary donations to support the campaign to end homelessness in our community.

VOLUNTEER

OUTREACH VOLUNTEERS: We need 100 or more volunteers to work in teams to interview homeless individuals to gain much needed information about themselves and their situation. This is a four day event. Each team will have the opportunity to thoroughly explore a designated geographical area for the three days of the Homeless Point in Time Count. You will also be provided training related to interviewing persons experiencing homelessness and completing the survey forms.

- Thursday, January 26 – Meet with Team/Survey, 4-6 am (arrive by 3:45 am)
- Friday, January 27 – Meet with Team/Survey, 4-6 am (arrive by 3:45 am)
- Saturday, January 28 – Meet with Team/Survey, 4-6 am (arrive by 3:45 am)

HEADQUARTERS: We need volunteers at Headquarters during the mornings of the Point in Time count. Volunteers will help organize returning street count volunteers, assist with breakfast, and help with organization after the count each day. This is a 5:30am to 7:30 am shift, the same days as the outreach volunteers above. The Wednesday evening training will also be part of this volunteer assignment.
