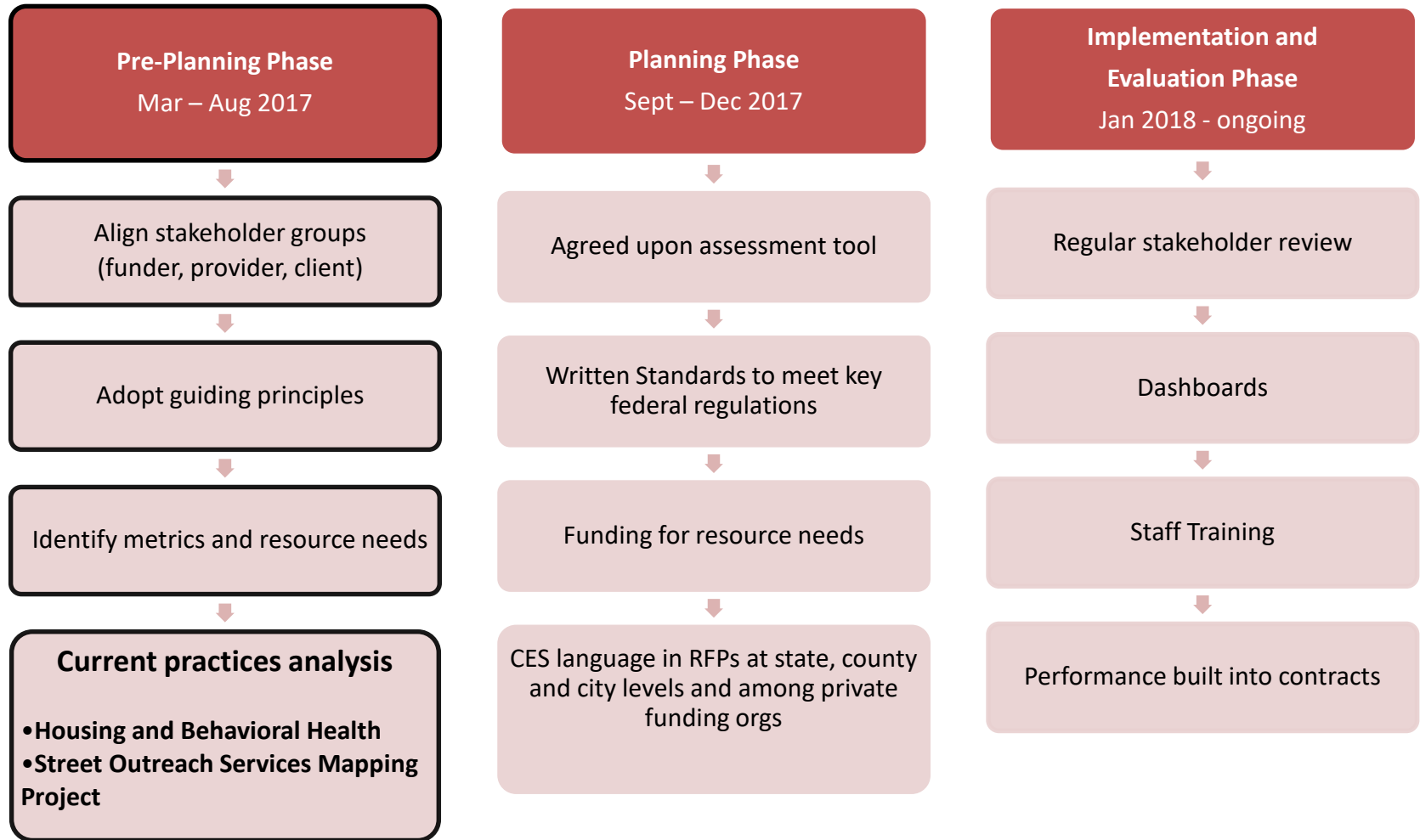
Background

- Coordinated Entry is about connections
- Requires system focused work by funders and providers
- Top Priority of Collective Impact and a component of the HB 441 Strategies
- Top Priority of Salt Lake County

CURRENT PRACTICES ANALYSIS:

HOUSING AND BEHAVIORAL SERVICES PILOT PROJECT



Result

Provider network developed pilot operational solution to **connect** people to housing and supportive services.

Up to 50 disabled persons experiencing long-term homelessness be **connected to supportive housing**



Stakeholder Workgroups

- **Funders Workgroup** – focused on how to develop cross-sector funding alignment for the community’s coordinated entry system
- **Provider Workgroup** – focused on how to operationalize an integrated community network
- **Client Workgroup** – focused on assuring the perspective of persons with lived experience is integrated into the system design and evaluation

First Meeting:

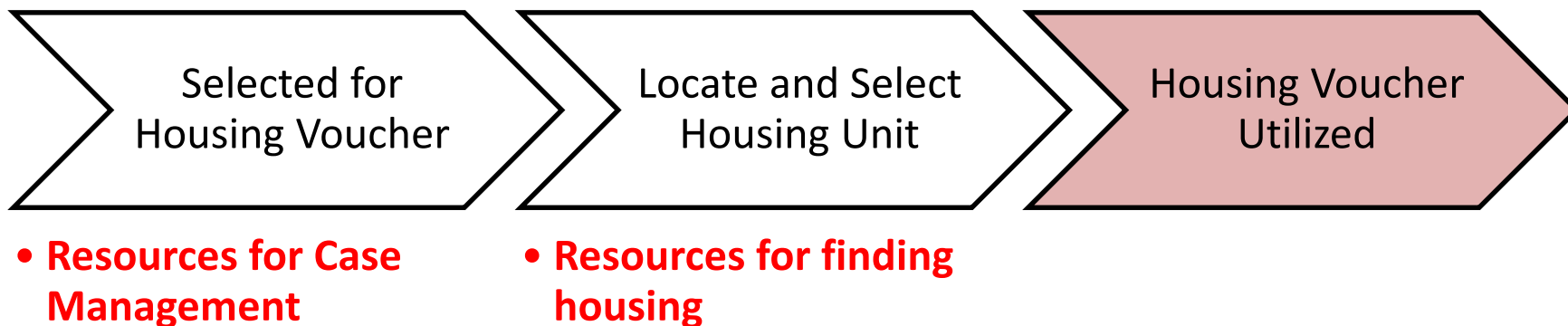
- Convened by Salt Lake County

Funder Alignment

Two Funders:

- Both are highly restrictive funding sources
- Different abilities in the “funder role”
- Shared agreement with Collective Impact:
Vision, Outcomes and **CES Guiding Principles**

Shared focus on supporting programs in order to help people; connecting people to needed housing and services.
