Draft safety improvements for Emigration Canyon to be unveiled

Emigration Township, Utah – The Emigration Canyon Roadway Improvement Committee, or ECRIC, will unveil its draft safety recommendations at an open house tomorrow evening. This is the first look at the work the committee has been doing for the last two months to solve safety concerns in one of Salt Lake County’s most scenic and heavily used canyons.

The stakeholder driven committee was created to find collaborative solutions to safety issues in Emigration Canyon. The committee will present its final recommendations to the County Council next month.
