Volunteers sought for Historic Preservation Commission

Salt Lake County, UT – Looking to identify and preserve historic places in the unincorporated areas of Salt Lake County, the Office of Township Services is reinvigorating the Historic Preservation Commission and looking for interested applicants.

The Commission will be tasked with identifying and inventorying historic sites and landmarks throughout the unincorporated area, as well as helping secure grant funding to protect these community treasures.

Commission members will comprise representatives from each of the County's six townships – Copperton, Emigration Canyon, Kearns, Magna, Millcreek, White City—and one to represent the remaining areas of Granite, Sandy Hills, Willow Canyon, and Willow Creek. Applicants must live in the unincorporated area.
