



“I Make a Difference” 2019 Contest Terms and Conditions

1. There is no purchase necessary to enter or to win, nor is there any cost to apply.
2. If the Applicant submitting the entry is under 18 years of age, Applicant agrees to get permission from parent or legal guardian before submission of artwork. Youth Services strongly recommends the parent or legal guardian sign the Consent and Release Form.
3. By submitting the entry, Applicant is warranting that the submitted artwork is original and non-professional. For any submission that includes photo or video of multiple individuals, those individuals must agree to the submission of their photo or video in the contest. Any individual under age 18 should also have their parent/legal guardian sign the Consent and Release Form.
4. By submitting the entry, Applicant is granting Youth Services, including local media, the right to use the submitted artwork for communication purposes for an unlimited time.
5. By submitting the entry, Applicant agrees and hereby releases Youth Services and its nonprofit partner Shelterkids Inc., employees, and board members from any and all liability or responsibility arising in connection with the Applicant’s participation in the contest or as to any prize(s) which may be awarded.
6. Youth Services reserves the right at its sole discretion to reject and disqualify any entry deemed in its sole discretion to be obscene, profane, offensive, lewd, pornographic or otherwise inappropriate. Youth Services also reserves the right to ask Applicant to revise and/or edit written submissions.
7. Youth Services assumes no responsibility for entries unable to be processed for any technical reason and further reserves the right to cancel the contest if it becomes technically corrupted or because of unauthorized human intervention. Youth Services reserves the right in the event of such cancellation to award the prize to an eligible, non-suspect entry received prior to cancellation.
8. Applicant agrees that entry and acceptance of prize constitutes permission for Youth Services to have the option of using the first name of applicant and entry in any submitted artwork. Such use will be without compensation and may be for editorial, public relations, promotional or advertising purposes, or any other purpose as deemed reasonable by Youth Services.
9. This contest is limited to Utah Residents age 10-18 only. Applicable taxes are the responsibility of the Applicant.

11. The winning selections will be posted online after the close of the voting period. Winners will be announced and awarded prizes at the Environmental Health Division on April 19th. Winners are given first priority; all others will be displayed as space allows.

13. Contest submission opens on March 15th and closes on April 8th. No entries submitted after that date will be considered for the contest. Entries should be submitted to or dropped off to Youth Services C/ O Noelle Reymond by 7pm on April 8th 5 PM MST.
14. I Make a Difference Committee will vote on the top 12 entries including 1st, 2nd and 3rd place. This committee will be staffed by Youth Services employees.
15. Youth Services reserves the right to adjust the rules, terms and conditions of the “I Make a Difference” contest as necessary.
16. Top 12 submissions will be displayed at Youth Services for one year. In order for artwork to be displayed, artwork must be 8 ½ by 11 inches or smaller for framing purposes.
