Onsite employee flu clinics will offer Fluzone influenza vaccine FREE to all merit employees. This vaccine protects against four strains of influenza and is approved for people over the age of 6 months. Family members who are not employees are also welcome, but they must bring their health insurance card to be billed.

Primary insurance plans accepted: SelectHealth, United Health Care, PEHP, EMI Health, Blue Cross Blue Shield (NOT Focal Point Plan), Medicare, Medicaid.

In addition to Fluzone, the health department also offers two other types of influenza vaccine:

Fluzone High-Dose: Because your immune system weakens as you age, this vaccine is specifically for people over the age of 65. It protects against three strains of influenza.

FluBlok: This vaccine is recommended for people aged 50-64. It protects against 4 strains of influenza and contains more of the active ingredient than Fluzone for stronger protection. This vaccine is approved for use in people 18 years and older, and is completely egg-free and safe for people with egg allergies.

If you would rather receive either of these vaccines, please make an appointment at a Salt Lake County immunization clinic by calling 385-468-SHOT (7468). You will need to bring your insurance card to any appointment at a clinic.
