Information Services – Geographic Information Systems Team

The GIS team of Information Services provides a number of services for Salt Lake County users of GIS.

- Consulting Services for new and existing GIS users to help determine how GIS fits into their Business needs.
- Management of shared GIS software licenses.
- Provides a data infrastructure that allows Salt Lake County organizations to create, maintain, and share GIS information. This also allows the creation of GIS information that can have controlled and limited access
- Provides the infrastructure for publishing GIS information to the intranet (internal to the County) and to the internet (the public)
- Assistance in making GIS data available to the public through the web
- First level of support for users of the ESRI GIS software
- Analysis of information in a spatial context. Examples of spatial analysis are:
 - ◊ Determining how many clients are in within a boundary such as a council district or zip code
 - ◊ Finding how many how many patrons are within a certain distance of a recreation center
 - ◊ Finding out if there is a correlation between income from the US census and services delivered
